ASSISTED LIVING

The care that each resident receives at Carolina Gardens is unique to his or her needs. Each resident is assessed upon move-in and regularly thereafter. This ensures our residents are always receiving the proper care for their needs. Our focus is on overall wellness and supporting independence.

Benefits of Assisted Living

1. Safety. Our number one priority is safety of our residents, and our communities are equipped with safety railings, safety bars, and a trained staff.

2. Medication Management. Through your physician's orders and our preferred pharmacy, we can take care of ordering, storing and administering medications.

Our Life Enrichment Director meets with new residents individually to complete detailed activity profiles, learn about their interests, and develop plans to meet their particular needs. Our outings consist of attending local college baseball games, going to parks and lakes for picnics. We also go to the Greenville Zoo, and head to North Carolina to pick apples and to see the fall leaves change. We have also taken the men to the lake for a day of fishing and the ladies for a lunch and a pontoon boat ride.



The average square footage of our apartments is 275 with faux wood vinyl flooring in the living areas and a faux vinyl tile in the bathrooms. All rooms are painted a neutral color with window blinds.

We have a front porch where our residents enjoy rocking in the Carolina sunshine. We also have a back patio with tables and chairs. We have hosted a 4th of July BBQ, a Memorial Day BBQ, a family cookout with a local band playing. Our residents enjoy eating popsicles on warm days on the back patio.
